
Sir,

Henceforth, eligible parents/brothers/sisters will be required to submit declaration in the revised format as at annexure to this letter, for claiming dependent pension.

2. These orders are effective from the date of issue of this letter and shall apply to all cases pending finalization on that date. Cases already decided need not be reopened .
