**Important/Significant achievements in the Department of Ex-Servicemen Welfare including Minimum Government Maximum Governance during August, 2019:-**

The following are the significant achievements in the Department of Ex-Servicemen Welfare including Minimum Government Maximum Governance during August, 2019:-

- (i) Sanction issued by Deptt. of Ex-Servicemen Welfare vide letter No. 22D(08)/2018-D(WE/Res-I) dated 8.8.2019 for revised scale of medical equipment (Dental) for ECHS Polyclinics.
- (ii) Sanction issued by Deptt. of Ex-Servicemen Welfare for purchasing of land (on perpetual lease hold basis) at Geeta Colony, Shadara, New Delhi from DDA for construction of permanent building for ECHS Polyclinic, East Delhi vide letter No. 22C(03)/2019/WE/D(Res) dated 28.8.2019.
- (iii) A Job Fair in collaboration with CII (Confederation of Indian Industries) was organised on 23.8.2019 at Ahmedabad. The Job Fair was inaugurated by Hon'ble Raksha Rajya Mantri, Shri Shripad Naik. A total of 1526 Ex-Servicemen and 31 corporates took part in the Job Fair for 559 vacancies offered by the Corporate Companies present at the Job Fair.
- (iv) A dashboard to monitor and review the mission and objectives of the department has been completed/ operationalised during this month. The dashboard has been made on the Darpan portal provided by NIC (National Informatics Centre) and provides infographics on real time basis at a glance of all the points included in the 100 days agenda and the annual action plan.
- (v) As per the action plan, the department and its attached offices undertook a nationwide Campaign on JSA (Jal Shakti Abhiyan) on 17.8.2019. Posters and other informational material on the theme were prepared and shared widely with all field Offices/Establishments i.e. DRZs (Directorate Resettlement Zones)/ RSBs (Rajya Sainik Boards)/ ZSBs (Zila Sainik Boards)/ Polyclinics. Every Zila Sainik Board adopted one village and carried out various water conservation related activities on this day.
- (vi) An amount of Rs. 1,41,91,462/- was disbursed under the Defence Service Estimate (DSE) Budget during the month for the Nepal Bhartiya Gorkha Sainik Board (NBGSB) and the Kendriya Sainik Board. The Progressive disbursement under DSE Budget so far is Rs. 19,45,98,024/-.
- (vii) Financial assistance of Rs. 35,58,000/- to 173 cases was released under the Raksha Mantri's Ex-Servicemen Welfare Fund (RMEWF) during the month. The Progressive disbursement so far is Rs. 36,45,30,000/-.
- (viii) An amount of Rs. 46,58,914/- was disbursed out of the Armed Forces Flag Day Fund for various welfare activities during the month, the progressive disbursement in the year so far being Rs. 37,17,24,699/-.
