

Important /Significant achievement in the Department of Ex-Servicemen Welfare including Minimum Government Maximum Governance during June, 2019:-

The following are the significant achievements in the Department of Ex-Servicemen Welfare including Minimum Government Maximum Governance during June, 2019:-

- (i) Sanction for acquisition of lands at Giddalur village and Chittor for construction of Type 'C' Ployuclinics were issued vide MoD letter no, 22D(05)/2018/WE/D(Res-I) dated 14.06.2019 and 22C(03/2018/WE/D (Res-I) dated 17.06.2019 respectively. Sanction for obtaining State Govt. land for construction of ECHS Type 'D' Polyclinic at Eluru also issued vide MoD letter no. 22C(01)/2017/WE/D(Res) on 19.06.2019.
- (ii) A Entrepreneurship-cum-Resettlement Seminar was conducted by DRZ (North) at 'Richen Auditorium' Leh on 22.06.2019. A DGR stall was established for the Veterans and the event was conducted in the form of interactive lectures. The seminar focused on guiding the veterans and retiring personnel towards various re-employment opportunities. The seminar was attended by about 100 veterans and 200 retiring personnel.
- (iii) The 5th International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21.06.2019 at Central Sainik Rest House Naraina. Lecture/ Practical Yoga Session were conducted by the proficient Yoga Instructors. The event was attended by all the staff of DESW and its attached offices.
- (iv) An amount of Rs. 4,33,043/- has been disbursed towards the Central share for the maintenance of RSBs/ZSBs in the states of Punjab, UP and Nepal Bhartiya Gorkha Sainik Board under the Defence Service Estimate Budget. The Progressive disbursement so far is Rs. 18,03,97,051/-
- (v) Financial assistance of Rs. 4,06,000/- 17 cases has been released under the Raksha Mantri's Ex-Servicemen Welfare Fund (RMEWF) during this month.
- (vi) An amount of Rs. 4,06,000/- was disbursed out of the Armed Forces Flag Day Fund for various welfare activities during the month. The progressive disbursement in the year so far is Rs. 4,46,685.

- (vii) 335 Ex-Servicemen (ESM) have been provided employment in Government, and 148 in the Non-Government Sectors. 28 ESM have been provided Self-Employment Schemes and 50 officers and 740 JCOs/OR were provided resettlement training during the month.
- (viii) The Number of ESM/ dependents registered for Digital Life Certificate up to 31st May, 2019 is 5,03,934.
- (ix) This month, we worked on preparing a vision statement of the Department of Ex-Servicemen Welfare for the next years. After detailed deliberations and consultations we have prepared a plan for 100 days achievement as well as annual action plans for the next five years.
